COVID 19 Plan – Public Works Department
Updated: April 16, 2020

Due to the closure of the City's Compost Center because of the impacts of the COVID-19 social distancing requirements, beginning on Monday, April 20, 2020 the City's Sanitation Section will be providing the below services on regular resident collection days. Please remember this is temporary. Once the COVID-19 conditions allow for the opening of the Compost Center, the City will once again require stickers be placed on yard waste bags / bundled brush and additional refuse items be brought to the Compost Center.

Yard Waste:

- Yard Waste Bags – Curbside collection of 8 bags maximum per collection day, no stickers, twice per week.
- Brush – Curbside collection 8, 4-foot tied bundle, maximum per collection day, no stickers, twice per week.

Additional Refuse Items:

- Collection of bulk items or non-typical household garbage will be collected at the curb twice per week. There will be no charge for these additional items placed at the curb. A maximum of 2 cubic yards will be collected (equal to one refuse scooter full or the pick-up bed of a pick-up truck). No concrete, bricks, railroad ties, or hazardous materials will be accepted.

With the closure of the Compost Center, we hope these services help! City Council and City staff asks that residents follow these guidelines. Debris and yard waste created by contracting firms should still not be disposed of curbside. These additional services will be evaluated on an ongoing basis and may change. Any changes will be communicated via the City's website, Constant Contact, and Facebook Page.
